Its Integrated Quality Management System is audited and certified by AENOR and IQNet. Teczone applies strict quality control to all its finished products. For sandwich panels, structural tests, core density, thermal conductivity, dimensional stability, water absorption, etc. are carried out, among others. For all other products, dimensional and geometric controls, quality of punching, perforations, etc. are carried out, verifying that the manufacturing tolerances indicated in the reference standards are respected.

#### **Accredited laboratory services**

The structural performance of TECZONE building systems, their fire resistance, acoustic insulation and thermal insulation have been verified through test campaigns in accredited laboratories (University of Navarra, Labein-Tecnalia, Afiti, etc.).

#### Sustainable Innovation

Our commitment to developing sustainable solutions has been reinforced by the integration into Kingspan. This drives us to continue designing products that combine energy efficiency with environmental friendliness.

#### Building a responsible future

# Environmental Performance Communication and the Planet Passionate programme

At Teczone, sustainability and respect for the environment are part of our identity. We have an integrated environmental management system, externally certified since 2007 and backed by ISO 14001 certification, which endorses our good practices in environmental management.

Our system allows us to identify and control all applicable environmental requirements, ensuring strict regulatory compliance through specific procedures. We have been granted Integrated Environmental Authorisation, one of the most demanding requirements for the industry, periodically reviewed through the evaluation of the Best Available Techniques (BAT).

In addition, we have implemented a Self-Protection Plan which includes clear procedures and trained personnel to act quickly and effectively in emergency situations, minimising damage and environmental impact.

#### Kingspan Group, sustainable actions in the Planet Passionate framework

The environmental aspects generated by our activities are systematically monitored and evaluated, which allows us to establish annual objectives aimed at minimising the impact on the company's environment. These actions are reinforced by our participation in the Kingspan Group's Planet Passionate programme, which aims to address global challenges such as climate change, the circular economy and the protection of nature, through specific initiatives such as the following:



#### Energy

- Maintain our net zero energy target.
- Increase our direct use of renewable energy to 60% by 2030.
- Increase on-site renewable energy generation to 20% by 2030
- Install solar photovoltaic panels in all proprietary facilities by 2030.



### Coal

- Achieve net carbon manufacturing by 2030.
- 50% reduction in CO2 emissions from raw materials supplied by our suppliers by 2030.
- Zero-emission company cars by 2025.



### Circularity

- One billion PET bottles recycled in our manufacturing processes by 2025.
- QuadCore insulation with recycled PET by 2025.
- Zero company waste to landfill by 2030.



#### Water

- 5 active projects to clean up the oceans
  - and seas by 2025.
- 100 million litres of rainwater collected by 2030.

We have taken a significant step towards on-site energy generation with the installation of photovoltaic panels at our Burgos plant. This action allows us to produce 40% of our electricity consumption, reducing our carbon footprint and optimising the use of renewable resources. This initiative is part of Planet Passionate, Kingspan's global plan to minimise the environmental impact of our operations.

In line with this commitment, we carry out responsible waste management at our Burgos plant based on recycling or energy recovery, avoiding the need to send waste to landfill and moving towards the goal of zero waste.

We have also progressively renewed our logistics fleet, incorporating two new electric forklifts. 60 % of our forklift trucks and 100 % of our company vehicles are now diesel-free. To support this transition, we have four electric vehicle charging points in the car park

Furthermore, we collaborate with local organisations alongside the Planet Passionate Communities Fund to develop environmental projects of interest, consolidating our positive contribution to the communities around us. Some of the organisations Teczone partnered with in 2024 include:

- Fundación Oxígeno Environmental volunteering and training workshops
- UBU Verde Environmental volunteering and the Kingspan-Teczone Sustainability Awards Ceremony at the University of Burgos
- Asociación Española Contra el Cáncer Burgos March against Cancer
- Hermandad de Donantes de Sangre Blood Donation

Furthermore, in recent years Teczone has ceased sending waste to landfill, water consumption has been optimised and green energy is used in manufacturing processes, and the company is in the process of replacing combustion-engine vehicles with electric vehicles, reducing the main cause of CO2 emissions.

# Communicating health and safety performance

Teczone has had a Health and Safety management system in place since 2007, in accordance with the requirements of ISO 45001, and has opted to report its Occupational Health and Safety performance on the website www.teczone.es, which also contains its quality, environment and Occupational Health and Safety policy.

In recent years, the investments and actions carried out in health and safety have been oriented as far as possible towards eliminating hazards and reducing risks, resulting in a reduction in accidents, with a 42% reduction in accidents requiring sick leave and a 33% reduction in accidents not requiring sick leave compared to the previous year. The target of not exceeding the previous year's frequency rate and incidence rate values has been met. These monitoring values, such as incidence rate, duration and absence, are well below the values stated by the Spanish National Institute of Statistics for the CNAE (Clasificación Nacional de Actividades Económicas, National Classification of Economic Activities) code for the metalworking sector\*.

In recent years, the collaboration and participation of the external accident prevention service has increased, with two visits received per month. During these days, staff training, risk assessments of the workstations and specific studies (such as measurement of internal noise, lighting or chemical agents and the safety inspections scheduled every three months) are carried out.

Personal protective equipment for regular use is supplied via a dispensing machine that ensures the availability of the material at any time of day, automatically recording the time and identity of the person who has taken it out.

Teczone conducts over 30 risk assessments regarding the various machines, which are renewed every five years or when significant modifications occur that could mean changes in the risks detected – all such assessments are currently up to date.

Training in occupational risk prevention is planned on an annual basis. In addition, various actions aimed at improving working conditions and safety in the plant have been reinforced:

- All the staff have received specific training in occupational risk prevention in the metal sector.
- The noise level in the plant has been reduced by soundproofing two lines and implementing process improvements to limit manual handling.
- Annual measurements of noise and chemical pollutants are carried out to ensure safe environmental working conditions.
- An emergency drill is carried out once a year, involving a full evacuation and confirmation that the safety systems are functioning correctly.

Communication and involvement are facilitated through regular meetings with section staff or accident prevention officers, as well as through posters, e-mails and the intranet of each factory section, where the relevant information is available and accessible at all times.

In recent years, the number of subcontractors providing services at our facilities has increased, with more than 150 interventions per year, for which purpose a system of coordination of business activities has been established, varying depending on the work required.

Teczone has a Self-Protection Plan, which was initially registered in 2016. As part of the planned activities, an annual drill is carried out during which the facilities are fully evacuated.
